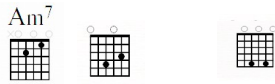
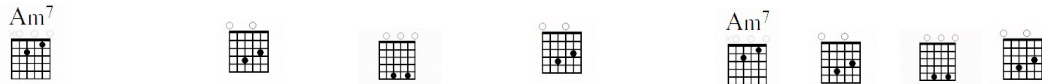


A MONSTER'S DINNER

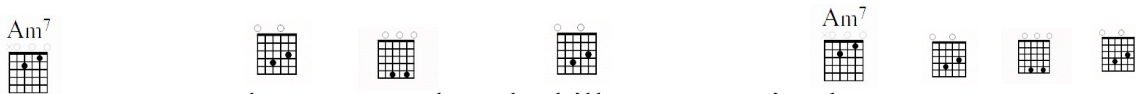
The main chord sequence consists of three very simple chords, which have long, unnecessarily complicated names. So I've cut the names. I play this with a capo on fret 3.



1(Am7) Chord2 Chord3



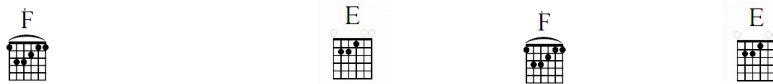
From where I sit the sky is blue, but the sun is going down



A star came out an hour ago when the hills were turning brown



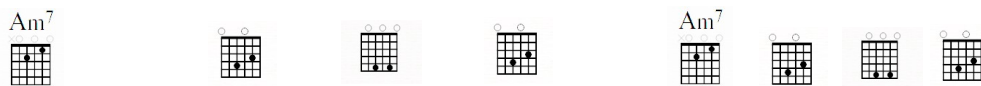
And from the depths of darkling trees the summer air is now a breeze



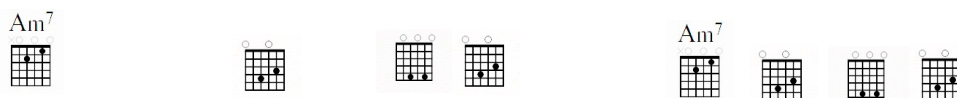
But something stirs which is not that, a grizzly bear, a mountain cat
